THE SYMBIOSIS OF SMART WITH TOURISM

has an important symbiotic relationship with tourism in Sonoma and Marin Counties. Tourists riding SMART make up a significant share of total ridership, providing revenue. At the same time, tourism is enhanced by a green network of rail, bike and shuttle with SMART as its backbone. This diminishes traffic and makes the touristic experience more attractive and relaxing. Since tourism is an important and increasing part of Marin and Sonoma County's economy, SMART tourism will provide economic support for SMART through increased sales taxes. As ecotourism increases globally, the North Coast needs a strong ecotourist brand. SMART is an important part of that. Altogether, tourism and SMART create a virtuous circle that benefits both.
